Professional Introduction

Prepare an introduction (A.K.A. 'elevator pitch') to share who you are, where you are in your career journey, where you are headed and how you are unique. You never know when you will meet someone who can help catalyze your future professional path.

- **WHO YOU ARE**: Name, Major or interested field of study, professional credentials. (It's okay to share if you are still exploring these areas!)
- **2** YOUR CAREER JOURNEY OR CAREER DIRECTION: Let them know the position or graduate program you would enjoy to pursue or possess one day.
- WHAT MAKES YOU DISTINCTIVE: Share your skills, experiences and/or leadership and how it would fit into an organization, problems you would like to solve, etc.
- **OPEN CONVERSATION WITH A QUESTION**: Ask about their career journey, their current professional interests, how they stay up to date with their industry or professional development, etc.

EXAMPLE TEMPLATE
